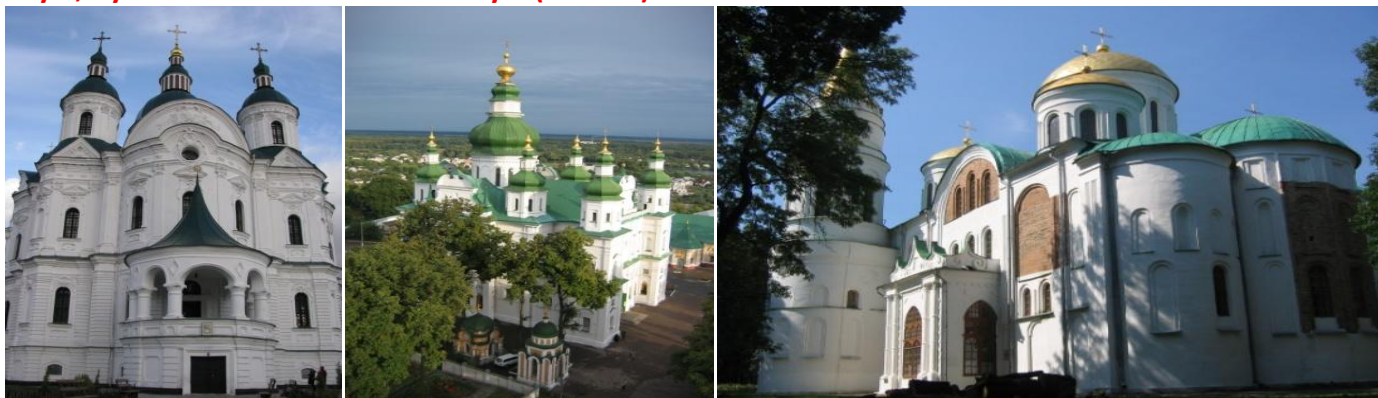


## Chernihiv

### A 1-day tour to Chernihiv

*“The competitor of Kyiv” – this is how Chernihiv is called by some historians when it goes about the Kyivan Rus’ epoch. Since the establishment of the city till the present times Chernihiv has always been one of the main centers of political, economic and cultural life of Ukrainians and is now renowned for its magnificent monuments. It is time to disclose its secrets and explore the old part of a city with the impressive churches and Antonyi caves. And don’t forget to drop in on Kozelets with its amazing baroque Cathedral.*

#### Day 1, Kyiv – Kozelets - Chernihiv – Kyiv (320 km)

**Kozelets** – the mid-18<sup>th</sup>-century Cathedral of the Blessed Virgin Nativity built in the late Ukrainian Baroque style with the amazing 27m-high iconostasis, the Regimental Chancellery Building (the current Town Hall).

**Chernihiv** –the historical places of the old part of a city – Boryso-Hlibsky Cathedral with the stunning silver Royal Doors, the Transfiguration Cathedral with its two distinctive bell towers, the Regimental chancellery, the burial-mounds on the Boldyn hill, Troyitsky and Illinsky Trinity Monasteries, the impressive Antonyi caves with 315 m of passageways, galleries and chapels.
