Getting to the place of lodging.

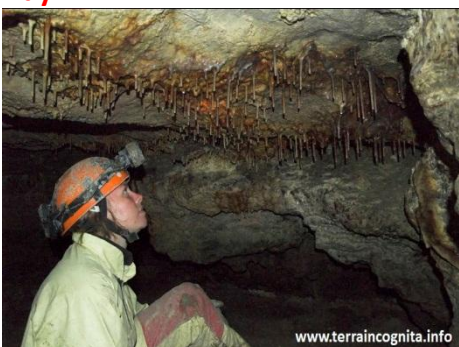
Lunch.
